#### Formal Access Application - Notice of Decision

I refer to your Formal Access Application under the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009* (the GIPA Act), which was received by the Department of Family and Community Services (FACS) on 10 May 2017, and your subsequent email of 28 June 2017, where you reduced the scope of your request to the following:

"The final reports by FACS in relation to the 11 children or young people aged 13 years or younger that were reported to FACS to be at risk of forced marriage as referenced by you in the decision letter for a previous GIPA, file number HOGIPA17/42. Please include the ages of the children, however, please exclude any reference to gender, dates (except the year), and cities/towns."

Please be advised that I have liaised with the relevant internal FACS business area, who were able to source and provide the relevant data/information requested, from the Key Information Directory System (KiDS). I have numbered the documents 1 to 54, inclusive.

I have carefully considered your request in view of the objectives of the GIPA Act where you have a legally enforceable right to obtain information, unless there is an overriding public interest against disclosure of the subject information. Further, I have also considered the requirements of section 74 of the GIPA Act, which provides that an agency may delete information from a record to which access is provided if the deleted information is not relevant, or within the scope of the information applied for, or an agency has decided to refuse access to that information.

I have decided to provide you with a copy of the information requested in your access application in accordance with section 58 of the GIPA Act, with the exception of a number of pages, which contain information that are subject to an overriding public interest consideration against disclosure under the GIPA Act. The decision schedule attached lists the documents that contain information where there is an overriding public interest consideration against disclosure. In the decision schedule, (P) means that a document has been withheld in part from disclosure.

In deciding which information to withhold in full or in part, I was required to conduct a "public interest test" where the public interest considerations favouring disclosure of government information were weighed against those factors that do not favour disclosure. The following are a number of public interest factors I considered which favour disclosure of the information requested:

- Disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to promote open discussion of public affairs, enhance Government accountability or contribute to positive and informed debate on issues of public importance
- Disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to inform the public about the operations of agencies and, in particular, their policies and practices for dealing with members of the public
- Disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to ensure effective oversight of the expenditure of public funds
- The information is personal information of the person to whom it is to be disclosed
- Disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to reveal or substantiate that an agency (or a member of an agency) has engaged in misconduct or negligent, improper or unlawful conduct
- Disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to advance the fair treatment of individuals in accordance with the law in their dealings with agencies
- Disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision
- Disclosure of the information could reasonably be expected to contribute to the administration of justice generally, including procedural fairness.

A number of documents have been withheld from disclosure as they contain information where a public interest factor against disclosure, outweighs the factors in favour of disclosure.

Information that has been withheld from disclosure under clause 10 of Schedule 1 of the GIPA Act relates to the care and protection of children. There is a conclusive presumption of an overriding public interest against disclosure of information contained in a report to which Section 29 of the *Children and Young Persons* (Care and Protection) Act 1998 applies.

Information that has been withheld from disclosure under clauses 1(d), 1(f) and 1(g) of the table to section 14 of the GIPA Act is information that would:

- Prejudice the supply to an agency of confidential information that facilitates the effective exercise of that agency's functions,
- Prejudice the effective exercise by an agency of the agency's functions, and

• Found an action against an agency for breach of confidence or otherwise result in the disclosure of information provided to an agency in confidence.

FACS relies on mandatory reporters and members of the public to alert this department to children who may be at risk. Divulging the identity of such reporters would place them at risk, as well as jeopardise the future supply of information, which may be relied on. Without the assistance of such reporters FACS would be unable to fulfil its child protection obligations, which is why it is paramount that reporter confidentiality must be maintained.

Further, it is a function of FACS to conduct investigations into allegations of child abuse and neglect to help determine whether child abuse or neglect has been substantiated. As FACS relies on people to provide information to the department regarding these incidents, FACS will keep such information confidential, unless those persons give permission in writing to disclose their identity, and the information.

I am satisfied that releasing the source and content of the information received by FACS as outlined above, could reasonably be expected to prejudice the future supply of such information to FACS. Further, I am of the view that the public interest in a person being aware of the allegations and the identity of the person making the allegations is the public interest in maintaining the anonymity outweighed by complainants/reporters. Accordingly, I determine that the release of the confidential information and its source fall within the scope of clauses 1(d), 1(f) and 1(g) of the table to section 14 of the GIPA Act and is not in the public interest to disclose.

Information that has been withheld from disclosure under clause 3(a) of the table to section 14 of the GIPA Act is information that would reveal an individual's personal information. An individual's personal information may include, but is not limited to, their identity, their date of birth, their residential address, contact telephone number, information relating to their involvement with FACS, etc. I am of the view that there is an overwhelming public interest against disclosing information that reveals an individual's personal information.

Information that has been withheld from disclosure under clause 7(1) of the table to section 14 of the GIPA Act is information communicated to FACS by the Government of another state, and is exempt information under interstate Freedom of Information legislation. Following a formal consultation made under section 54(1) of the GIPA Act, the Attorney-General's Department objected to the release of some of the information. Accordingly, I determine that the release of the information falls within the scope of clause 7(1) of the table to section 14 of the GIPA Act, and is not in the public interest to disclosure.

If you are aggrieved by any of the reviewable decisions in this notice of decision, you may seek a review under Part 5 of the GIPA Act, by requesting any one of the following:

 An Internal Review which must be lodged with the Right to Information Unit within 20 working days of this notice of decision. You must lodge your Internal Review at the address shown at the bottom of the first page and it must be accompanied by the appropriate application fee of \$40. • Alternatively, a request for an External Review may be lodged with either the Information and Privacy Commission, or the NSW Civil and Administrative Tribunal. Please note that you must lodge your request for an external review within 8 weeks of this notice of decision.

Further attached are receipts for the amounts of \$30, \$360 and \$360, that represent the fees for processing your Formal Access Application.
