LINKS aims to decrease trauma symptoms, increase psychological wellbeing and improve behavioural and emotional functioning.

To achieve these goals, multidisciplinary teams provide tailored, holistic interventions.

LINKS teams include psychologists, speech pathologists, occupational therapists, Aboriginal mental health clinicians and psychiatrists.

who's eligible?

LINKS is available to children in out-of-home-care. To be eligible, a child must:

- be aged 16 or under
- be able to attend Penrith or Newcastle Community Service Centre
- have had 2 or more placements in the past 6 months OR an increased need for respite care over the past 12 months

LINKS welcomes children in DCJ and agency placements.
